Responsibilities:

- Create a strategic plan with corresponding action steps for all of CEDO's social media outreach.
- Develop content and research/publicize community events
- Work with Program Managers to update and organize CEDO's inventory of social mediaworthy program photos.
- Make recommendation to user experience on CEDO's website.

Requirements (professional/skill requirements and time requirements):

- Students applying for this internship should have experience and an academic focus in communications, marketing, and or social media management
- Must own high resolution digital camera with the knowledge and skills to use it
- The willingness and ability to dedicate 10-15 hours per week on this internship
- Applicants must have access to a vehicle or some other form of reliable transportation to photograph in the field within Chittenden County. Occasional nights and weekends may be required.
